

## Southern Section 4-H Fashion Revue Guidelines

The Southern Section 4-H Fashion Revue is an annual event conducted through the cooperative efforts of the Southern California counties, in the Southern Section Leaders' Council and the University Cooperative Extension.

### The main objectives are to:

- \*Provide an opportunity for interaction among multi-county participants.
- \*Stimulate excitement and motivation for involvement in county and multi-county events
- \*Promote participation in the four categories of the 4-H Clothing and Textiles project.

Southern Section Fashion Revue will include competition in three levels:

**Juniors** (Ages 9-11), **Intermediates** (Ages 12-13), **Seniors** (Ages 14 and above)

There will be **NO Primary entries** for this event.

Each participant must be a current County Fashion Revue Winner in one of these six categories, **Traditional, Recycled, Purchased, Wearable Art, Needle Arts, or \$15 Challenge**. One alternate for each level may also be selected to compete **only** if their County Winner is unable to compete.

### Each participant may only enter in one category.

- \*If you were selected county winner in more than one category, you **must** pick only **one** to go on to the Sectional level.

Each participant will be judged on the "total picture" they portray in their garment. No judging of construction will be done, except as it appears in the overall results.

Each County Office must submit the following forms by **May 1, 2011**:

- \***Registration Master List**
- \***One County Check (\$2.00 per contestant)**  
(Payable to **Southern Section 4-H Leaders' Council**)
- \*Appropriate forms for each Contestant
  1. **Entry Form**
  2. **Supplemental Entry Form**  
(**Traditional, Recycled, Purchased, Wearable Art, Needle Arts, or Apron Challenge**)
  3. **Medical Release Form**
  4. **Code of Conduct Form**
  5. **Typed Commentary** (30-45 seconds long)

All information is required on each form in order to be judged in the Southern Section 4-H Fashion Revue. It is recommended that photocopies of completed entry forms be kept by each participant and county office.

**Location:** Mt. San Antonio College (Mt. Sac), 1100 N. Grand Ave. Walnut, CA.

**Free parking** is available in Lot G and Lot F. Do not park in handicapped spaces as citations will be issued.

**Lunch** may be purchased at the 4-H concession stand.
