The Southern Sectional 4H Fashion Revue will be held at Mt. San Antonio College on Saturday, May 21, 2011. We would like all nine counties represented. Sectional Fashion Revue 2011 will include Juniors (Ages 9-11) and Intermediates (Ages 12-13) along with Seniors (Ages 14 and above) in competition. **There will be no Primary entries for this event.** This day provides an opportunity to be judged at a higher level than County for our 4H youth.

Check-in will take place at 8:00 AM inside Building 28. Judging will begin at 9:00 AM and will last until 11:30 AM. All participants must model in the Fashion show, which is held in the main auditorium at 2:30 p.m. before the Awards Ceremony.

Medals will be awarded based on merit. If there is only one entry in a category, this does not automatically warrant a medal. All clothing must be appropriate and fashionable (no bathing suits or lingerie). The standard of excellence must be met as stated on the judging sheets.

Please duplicate this material for your County Fashion Revue Chairperson and other 4H offices in your county so they are aware of this opportunity and will have the forms ready to sign up their County Winners in each level (**Junior, Intermediate, Senior**) from each category (**Traditional, Recycled, Purchased, Wearable Art, Needle Arts, Apron Challenge**). One Alternate may be selected to be on stand-by at South Section Fashion Revue to compete only if one of your County Winners is unable to compete.
