2019-20 APPOINTMENT/RE-APPOINTMENT ONLINE COURSES ARE OPEN

To meet the requirements of USDA, University of California, and the 4-H Youth Development Program, volunteers are required to participate in yearly trainings related to positive youth development, cultural competency, and 4-H policy.

1. eXtension LMS - Create or login to your eXtension account and take the course at your own pace.

2. Statewide Webinar - Register and participate in one of the statewide webinars offered between July and December 2019. **Schedule of Statewide Webinars**

3. Countywide In-person - Contact your county office to see if they will be offering an in-person training for the new or returning volunteer courses.

4. Dates of Zoom Conference Calls. You need to register 24 hours in advance of times in advance.

5. Make sure you check email after you register for confirmation of conference call session once you register.
