

Teen Leader (Age 14 & Up): The Teen Leader needs to fulfill the responsibilities of being a junior leader in a specific project and/or approved by the Community Leaders in the 4-H Club. If the Community Leader doesn't think the teen is ready to be a teen leader; they will continue as a junior leader. Duties of the Teen Leader: Must be able to work and help conduct the individual project with the Adult Project Leader. Also, the teen leader is responsible for helping in contacting the individual members of his/hers project at least 4 days in advance by calling on the telephone (email is not recommended). The teen leader is to work along with the junior leader in his/her project in creating a Practice Judging Day Poster for the February Community Meeting as well as assisting with the annual Club Halloween Party in creating and running a carnival booth at the Halloween Party. Teen leader also keeps good records of what skills are being taught or learned at each project meeting and help the project members with their record books in June.

Junior Leader (Age 12 & 13 year old): The Junior Leader needs to be pre-approved by the Community Leaders to take on the responsibilities of being a junior leader in a specific project. Duties of the Junior Leader: Must be able to work in the individual project with the Adult Project Leader. Also, the junior leader is responsible in helping in contacting the individual members of his/hers project at least 4 days in advance by calling on the telephone (email is not recommended). The junior leader is to work along with the teen leader in his/her project in creating a Practice Judging Day Poster for the February Community Meeting as well as assisting with the annual Club Halloween Party in creating and running a carnival booth at the Halloween Party. Junior leader also keeps good records of what skills are being taught or learned at each project meeting and help project members with their record books in June.
